### SUMMARY

Assists with the installation, testing, and repair of DBS and related equipment that receive communication satellite signals for commercial customers, residential customers, and retail outlets by performing the following duties.

### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Reviews installation specifications, building permit, manufacturer's instructions, and government ordinances to determine installation site.
- Selects, orients and installs communication equipment, according to specifications, to meet customers' needs.
- Visually inspects installation site to identify obstructions, such as trees or buildings that could distort or block signals from satellite.
- Performs off air broadcast network signal strength test, per guidelines.
- Tests installed system for conformance to specifications.
- Instructs customer in use of equipment and ensures that documentation is effectively completed and submitted, as appropriate.
- Replaces or repairs defective parts.
- Accurately maintains van inventory and coordinates van maintenance schedules, to ensure vehicle is kept in good repair.
- Other duties as required. This list is not meant to be a comprehensive inventory of all duties and responsibilities assigned to this position.
